Walter Cronkite used to end his nightly news broadcast with the phrase,

"And that's the way it is."

To borrow that phrase, here's a brief background on why ClaimCompass is the best **WAY** for entering and reporting your First Report of Injury claims.

In the mid to late 1990s First Report software was just taking off. Several independent software companies released their solutions hoping to solve the ever-present problem of filling out a claim form and sending it to the state, carrier, etc. Many of those companies were successful and produced excellent software.

But three things happened that changed the game forever.

3 Changes...

1 Web-based solutions...

Between 1999 and about 2002, Windows® applications were replaced with web-based solutions.

2 EDI

Beginning around 2000 (and still happening), EDI emerged as the preferred way to send claims.

3 Acquisitions

From about 2000 to 2007 independent software companies went out of business, or were acquired.

Unintended Consequences

The software companies, for the most part, did a great job adapting to the **web**, **EDI**, and other changes in the market.

However... the loss of the independent software companies created an unintended consequence. They left a **huge hole** in the market. Since they were no longer independent, they could no longer serve the open market.

The Result?

There are some great software solutions out there for collecting and reporting First Report claims. The problem is, **you have to be part of their world** to use them - meaning, you have to be a customer of their insurance company, TPA, or other parent company **because they aren't independent.**
